Most organizations rely on volunteer officials to provide on-water race management, judging and umpiring.






US Sailing trains and certifies over 700 officials in the US.

- Experience SOARS
- Seminar inperson/online
- References
- SafeSport training
- Background check
- First Aid/CPR training





Seminars



- Basic and Advanced levels
- Available in-person locally
- Available online anywhere
- Classroom-style:
 - Instructor presentation
 - Interactive discussion
- Test online at your convenience (5-week window)



SafeSport Training



- Zero tolerance for abuse and misconduct, both afloat and ashore, in any US Sailing program
- Free online training provides education on:
 - Sexual Misconduct
 - Emotional and Physical Misconduct
 - Understanding Your Responsibilities for Reporting
- Initial core training followed by brief annual refresher training
- Required for all US Sailing race officials
