Clubhouse Facilities: Casual and formal restaurants and bars, banquet facilities for up to 400 pp.

Dining Hours: Breakfast served on Sundays (November – Mother's Day). Lunch and dinner served Sun. - Mon. - Tues. - Thurs. - Fri. - Sat. during Season (December 1 – May 1); Closed on Wednesdays.

Bar Hours: Same as restaurants.

Waterside Facilities: Harbor has transient slips available; shower facilities; fuel sales for transient boaters.

Docking: If dockage is required, please contact NYC's Dock Master at 239-262-7301. Liability insurance information will be requested during the reservation process.

Method of Introduction: Letter or email notice from club.

Dress Code: informal attire - collared shirts for men; jackets and ties not required; no denims of any kind for anyone please; gentlemen are expected to remove hats while indoors. Lunch dress code: smart casual, collared shirt, shorts permitted. Dinner dress code: smart casual, collared shirt, long pants. Yardarm – jacket is optional. Boater's Grille – smart casual, collared shirt, long pants or shorts permitted.

Method of Payment: MasterCard and VISA accepted. Not billed back to the reciprocal home club.

Limits on Guest Card Privileges: In season (December – May 1) one week, beginning with first day of visit. After season, less restrictive. During the "off season," (May 1 – November 30), a reciprocal club member can request an additional week. To request an extension, please contact the General Manager or Membership Director.

Local Facilities: Many restaurants, hotels, churches and the famous $3^{\rm rd}$ and $5^{\rm th}$ Avenue shops nearby; fishing charters and hotels nearby. Club has a few bicycles to use to get about town. Most activities are within walking distance of NYC.
