Location: Ocean Reef Club is located at the northern tip of Key Largo, approximately 50 miles by road southeast of Miami Airport. Its two thousand lush tropical acres are bordered on three sides by water. The Club can be reached by land, sea and air.

Clubhouse Facilities: Deluxe accommodations, 175 slip marina with full service Fishing Charters, Snorkeling & Scuba Diving, Fitness Center, Golf Course, Tennis Courts, Pickleball Courts, Private lagoon/beach and 2 pools, Full Service Salon & Spa, Dry Cleaning & Laundry, multiple restaurants.

Dining Hours: Dining at The Reef is all about options. A diversity of restaurants and lounges offer choices to suit every taste and formality, while an in-house catering team remains ready to create private dining experiences that range from black tie bashes on the beach and gala ballroom dinners to New England-style clambakes and simple golf course luncheons.

Waterside Facilities: 175 slip marina with full service Fishing Charters (Off Shore & Flats/Back Country), Snorkeling & Scuba Diving. For details, contact the Dockmaster's Office at 305-367-5908.

Method of Introduction: Reciprocal Club Members must notify the Ocean Reef Club Membership Office of their expected arrival at least 48 hours in advance. Their home club must fax an introductory letter to the Membership Office and a current club card from their home club must be presented upon their arrival.

Dress Code: The required attire for gentlemen in all restaurants is best described as "Club Casual" – collared shirts and dress trousers in the winter season and equally appropriate attire for ladies. If worn, shorts must be of walking length. Please note that smart long denim (jeans) are allowed in The Islander, Gianni's, Burgee Bar, Raw Bar and during breakfast service in The Ocean Room. During the winter season, sport coats are preferred on gentlemen in the member-only Golf Clubhouse with neckties optional.

Headwear: Gentlemen are expected to remove their hats whenever entering a Club facility, excluding the Raw Bar, where headwear is acceptable.

Cellular Telephones: Use of cell phones in any of the Club's restaurants is not permitted.

Recreation Attire: Cut-off, unhemmed and tattered jean shorts are not allowed. Each recreational area also has dress requirements.

Tennis & Croquet: Tennis requires appropriate tennis clothing and footwear and all-white attire must be worn on the Croquet Courts. Swim trunks and cotton t-shirts are not permitted.

Bathing Attire: Bathing cover-ups, as well as footwear, must be worn in all areas away from the beach and pools on Buccaneer Island. Thong-style bathing suits are not allowed.

Fitness Center & Outdoor Exercise: Shirts must be worn for jogging, walking and other forms of exercise within the community. All shirts worn by gentlemen within the community must have sleeves. Ladies' shirts must have full coverage.

Method of Payment: Credit card at check in (Mastercard, Visa, and American Express)

Limits on Guest Card Privileges: Reciprocal Club members must come to the Club by boat or accessing without coming by boat will be approved on a "case by case" basis. Reciprocal Club members can make reservations for the Inn or Marina for a limit of two visits a year with a limit of five days per visit. Members must be overnight guests in order to have access to the Club and its facilities.
