**Method of Introduction:** A letter/card of introduction is required in addition to some form of picture identification. Only those members of clubs with which a reciprocal agreement has been signed are accepted. A guest membership card is issued for the exclusive use of the visitor whose name appears on the card. They may bring in guests, including children, but must accompany them at all times. The card is not transferable.

**Dress Code:** Koa Lanai: Aloha wear is acceptable attire. Hau Terrace: Casual dress is permitted. Snack Shop: Beach wear is acceptable. Ka Moi Boathouse: Casual dress is permitted.

**Method of Payment:** The club accepts cash, personal checks, Visa, Mastercard, or American Express for payment. There is no credit limit and we bill the visiting member directly.

**Limits on Guest Card Privileges:** Reciprocal members may visit the Club for a maximum of 12 weeks in a 12 month period. Membership cards are issued for a maximum of 2 weeks at a time. Accounts must be paid in full before extensions may be granted. The Club reserves the right to restrict reciprocal club usage during certain periods.

There is a \$15 charge for a two day guest card. \$30 per week per guest card. There is a 4.712% State of Hawaii general excise tax added to all charges and a 15% server gratuity added to all food and beverage charges. In addition, 20% of the gross amount of bill is charged as dues.
