Dining

Dress Code

The Bridge Dining Room: Gentlemen must wear neat clean slacks/jeans, collared shirts, and closed-toed shoes; ladies will wear comparable attire.

The Commodore's Room: The Bridge Dress Code applies, and gentlemen are also requested to wear a jacket.

The Main Bar, Skipjack & Sailing Center: Clean, neat slacks/jeans or shorts and a sports shirt.

Unacceptable attire:

Bathing suits, bare tops, jeans or shorts with any rips, holes, or frays, bare feet, sleeveless athletic shirts, gentlemen with hats or caps inside

Clubhouse Etiquette

Members of reciprocal clubs are responsible for their guests while at the Club.

The use of electronic devices is allowed as long as they do not emit a sound. Cell phones must be kept on silent or vibrate and all audible conversations need to take place outside, in the front of the Clubhouse or on the docks.
